Each team plays four games. 1st and 2nd Place are determined by points at the conclusion of play.

The A section fields are in the main Singletary Soccer Complex at Remington Park.

The TCCHS fields are located near Thomas County Central High School.

Exiting the soccer complex, turn right onto Remington. Turn left onto Pinetree Blvd. Remain on Pinetree for approximately 1.5 miles. Turn right just before Victory Baptist Church onto Charlie Ward Blvd. TCCHS 1 (the Football Practice Field on the map) is just ahead on the right. TCCHS 2 (the Soccer Practice Field) is just ahead on the left.

To reach the Thomas County Central Middle School Field, CMS field, *continue on Charlie Ward Blvd, passing TCCHS on the left. Turn left onto the Highway 84 Truck Route/Bypass. Travel a short distance and you will see the middle school and soccer field just ahead on the right. Alternately, you can reach the Middle School by traveling north on US Highway 19, turning left at the US 84 Truck Route, and traveling 0.7 miles until you see the field on the right.*

The THS field is located at the Thomasville High School track, 315 S. Hansell St., between Remington Ave. and E. Jackson St. *Exiting the Remington Park fields, turn left onto Remington. Follow Remington approx. 1.2 miles and turn right onto Hansell St. The High School will be ahead on the right. Turn into the parking lot. The track field is located at the far side of the parking lot, at the bottom of the hill.*
